The **Cases in Success** program has received many positive comments from participants. These web-based, interactive case studies offer self-directed learning that fits into your busy schedule. Three different therapeutic areas are currently available:

- ▲ Strategies for Reaching Multiple Metabolic Targets
- ▲ Incretin Therapies
- ▲ Insulin Therapy

Each therapeutic area is comprised of 3 case studies, requiring 15-20 minutes per case. For each therapeutic area, you will:

- *Complete a brief pre-assessment and the first case study.*
- *Two weeks later, CADRE will prompt you to complete the second case in that area at a time convenient for you.*
- *Two weeks following completion of the second case, CADRE will prompt you to complete the third case in that area, as well as a brief post-assessment and the series evaluation--again, when convenient for you. Credit for the therapeutic area will be earned once the post-assessment is complete.*
- *Three months later, you will be asked to complete a follow-up assessment. Although this assessment is voluntary, its completion will help CADRE gauge the success of this novel program and plan future education activities.*

Complete CME information is provided at the beginning of each series of cases; completion of all cases in a series is required to earn 1.0 CME credit for the area.
